







Introduction

This portal has been designed to give providers of COSD cancer data rapid, quality feedback on the quality of their submissions. It allows users to look at the completeness of key data items and to conduct comparisons with local, regional and national averages to calculate relative performance.


The portal will be a continued development, incorporating useful metrics and measures with the aim of improving the quality of data flowing to the National Cancer Registration Service and ultimately, informing improvements in patient care and outcomes.

Background

The Cancer Outcomes and Services Dataset (COSD) Data Transfer Partnership Agreements (DTPAs) together with the COSD Conformance Framework provide guidance for submission of the dataset and how conformance with the COSD Information Standard is reported and monitored. Providers are expected to agree the data files that they submit for COSD in their DTPA with their local office of the National Cancer Registration Service (NCRS). The DTPA will be renewed annually. [Copies of your COSD DTPA are available from your local NCRS branch office on request]

The Framework will require on-going development to take account of other generic and sitespecific data items. This will be developed in consultation with key stakeholders particularly local clinical teams and the NCIN Site Specific Clinical Reference Groups (SSCRGs)

The implementation of COSD will be managed by the NCRS directly with its data providers. The principal approach will be to work in partnership with clinicians and their information, management and multi-disciplinary teams to implement the Standard successfully. The NCRS is strengthening the resources and coordination of its Data Liaison team to make sure that there is constructive dialogue with regard to improving the timeliness and quality of data provided. However, in the event that such constructive dialogue is not having the desired effect, the Framework includes an escalation process using leverage at various levels to try to bring things back on track.


