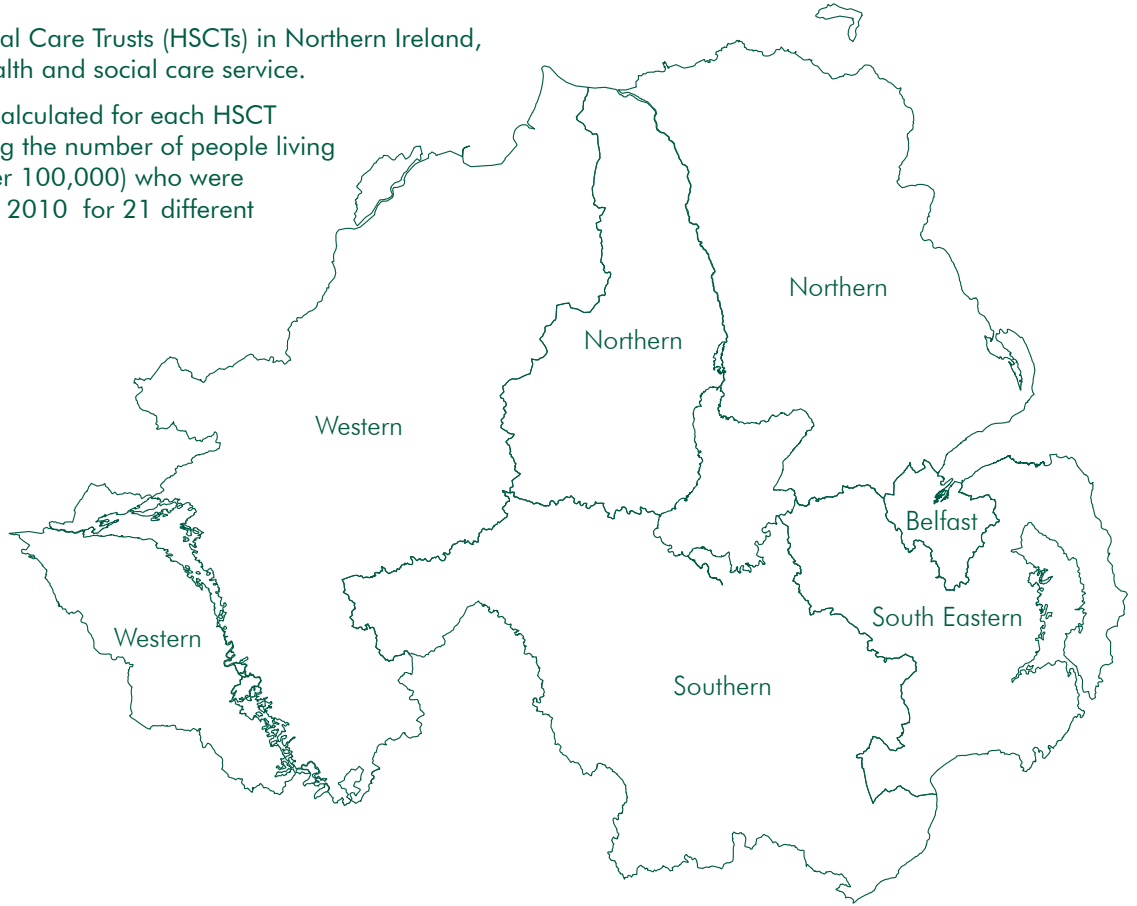


Health and Social Care Trusts in Northern Ireland

There are five Health and Social Care Trusts (HSCTs) in Northern Ireland, who provide an integrated health and social care service.

Cancer prevalence has been calculated for each HSCT in Northern Ireland, identifying the number of people living with cancer (and crude rate per 100,000) who were diagnosed between 1993 and 2010 for 21 different common cancer sites.



Local Government Districts in Northern Ireland

At the time of data extraction, during the Macmillan-NCIN UK Cancer Prevalence Project, there were 26 Local Government Districts in Northern Ireland as at 2013/14. (Note that since April 2015 these boundaries have been replaced and there are now 11 Local Government Districts in Northern Ireland.)
